## How to make your passport

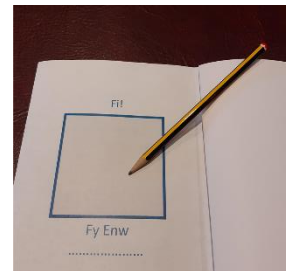
1. Print a copy of the Passport Cover (set your printer to 'print both sides, flip the short edge.')



2. Fold the paper in half to make the front and back cover of your passport.





3. Add folded paper to the inside to make a book.
4. Draw a picture of yourself in the photo frame and add your name.




## How to use your passport

1. Each time you visit the St Davids Cathedral website you can collect a stamp picture.
2. Print the pictures.
3. ✂ Cut out the pictures and glue into your passport
4. ✎ Complete the activity
