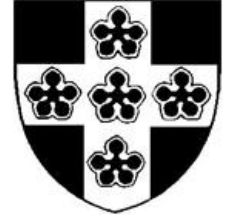




Eglwys Gadeiriol Tyddewi St Davids Cathedral

Dear all,

I wanted to write to you to let you know that we are returning to public worship for **Mothering Sunday**, with a special Family Service at 10 am – this service will also be live streamed and in addition to this the 11.15 am service will be broadcast as usual at 11.15 am. We will be following the same safety protocols as when we returned to public worship in the autumn, so no congregational singing and masks to be worn at all times whilst in the building.

Please find attached/enclosed the poster for our Mothering Sunday service.

Public Worship returns to a more regular pattern from Palm Sunday – the draft schedule for public worship during Holy Week can be seen overleaf. Following the Easter holidays there will be a review regarding the daily worship, with the reintroduction of daily Eucharists as well as weekday evensongs – something similar to the pattern last November.

Maggie and Jo Rose will be leaving St. Davids on the 23rd March. They have been a huge support to the life of the cathedral during their time with us, not only in the parish but also within the life of the city too – they will be sorely missed. Hopefully as the restrictions are lifted, we will begin to see you back at the cathedral for worship again.
